In 2016, the following BSCDB meetings were successfully organized:

The **2016 BSCDB Spring meeting** on "**Stem Cells as Disease Model and for Gene Therapy**", which was co-organized with the Belgian Society for Stem Cell Research (BeSSCR) as a 1st Joint Meeting on May 27, 2016, in Brussels.

Mateo Boretto (KUL) for his poster presentation entitled: "ORGANOID-ing mouse endometrium."


Joke Robijns (UA) for her poster presentation entitled: "Detection and reduction of nuclear rupture in genome edited model cells."

The **2016 BSCDB autumn meeting** on "**Cell Adhesion and Communication**" organized on October 13-14, 2016, in Ghent. Part of this meeting was devoted to honour prof. Frans Van Roy on the occasion of his retirement, as well to honour dr. Sophie Laguesse as the 2016 awardee of the BSCDB PhD Excellence Award.

Four poster prizes of €250 were awarded to:

Stefano Sala (UGENT) for his poster presentation entitled: "The tumour suppressor Testin: determination of domain specific interactions and dimer formation in vitro and in cells."

Astrid Deryckere (KUL) for her poster presentation entitled: "Smad-interacting-protein 1 (Sip1, Zeb2) controls cell fate decisions in the post-natal neurogenic niche."





Odile Bartholomé (ULG) for her poster presentation entitled: "Study of the SV2A protein role in Epilepsy."

Steven Goossens (UGENT) for his poster presentation entitled: "The EMT transcription factor Zeb2 regulates adult murine hematopoietic differentiation through altered cytokine signalling."

In 2016, the following BSCDB travel grant applications were awarded:

Joanna Bouchat (UNAMUR): €336 for attending the "FENS Forum" (Copenhague, Denmark, July 2-7, 2016), with the following abstract: "Oligodendrocytopathy and astrocytopathy precede myelin loss and blood- brain barrier disruption in a mouse model of osmotic demyelination syndrome."

Silke Smolders (UHASSELT): €500 for attending the "CSHL workshop on schizophrenia and related disorders" (Cold Spring Harbor, USA, June 8-15, 2016), with the following abstract: "Does maternal immune activation lead to neuropsychiatric disorders through altered brain development?"

Giuseppina Grieco (UCL): €500 for attending the "12th International Congress of Cell Biology" (Prague, Czezch Republic, July 21-25, 2016), with the following abstract "Disruption of endocytosis by PI3K-III/Vps34 ablation in kidney proximal tubules preserves epithelial polarity specification but causes lethal membrane trafficking imbalance."

Niels Vandamme (UGENT): €500 for attending the "SMR Melanoma Congress" (Boston, USA, November 6-9, 2016), with the following abstract: "Subpopulations of melanoma cells with distinct biological properties exhibit varying levels of ZEB proteins."

Daniela Sommer (UHASSELT): €400 for attending the "Protease World in Health and Disease Congress" (Kiel, Germany, September 14-17, 2016), with the following abstract: Macrophage-specific ADAM17 deficiency to control inflammation and regenerative processes after spinal cord injury."

2017 BSCDB Travel Awards - Application deadlines

Pre-doctoral researchers and junior post-doctoral researchers (max 2 years after obtaining the PhD degree) can apply for travel grants of at maximum 400 € (within Europe) or 500 € (outside Europe) for the purpose of attending an international meeting in the broad field of cell and developmental biology. In 2017, the BSCDB will award 4-6 of these travel grants.

The following application deadlines will apply:

- **31/05/2017** for conferences between 01/06/2017 and 31/08/2017.
- **31/08/2017** for conferences between 01/09/2017 and 31/12/2017.


